



# Planning for the Future

## Workshop Series 2008

**PIN offers a series of three workshops, broadly entitled 'Planning for the Future'. The aim of the workshops is to develop an understanding of Planned Individual Networks (PIN), plus gain valuable information on Planning for the Future – enabling families to plan the long term security of their relative.**

### **Orientation to PIN**

The Orientation to PIN provides an introduction to the vision, purpose, guiding principles and values of Planned Individual Networks. During the Orientation, the services PIN provides to families and the community will be discussed along with an in depth review of how PIN assists families in building individual, personal Networks around their relatives with disabilities. This will include, starting a Network, the rationale, ongoing maintenance and safeguards, as well as the long term impact on the lives of our families and relatives with disabilities. This workshop is ideal for those wishing to learn more about PIN.

### **Planning for the Future Seminar**

This event is a natural progression from the Orientation to PIN and takes people through the important steps of setting up or reviewing a will (this is particularly relevant where relatives are approaching or have reached adulthood) and will address the concepts of Trusts and Estate Planning. This Seminar is presented by Michael Sayer, the Principal of The Corporate Will Company. Michael is also an Advisor to PIN, and has many years experience in compiling financial and future plans (family succession) tailored to individual families. His presentation explores options in the estate planning and succession field which many find confronting and painful, but essential for the long term safety, security and peace of mind for all our family members.

### **Planning for the Future Workshop**

It is recommended that participants have already attended the Orientation to PIN and the Planning for the Future Seminar, as this Workshop builds on knowledge gained previously. Michael Sayer will facilitate a practical hands-on workshop using a workbook, drawing on a variety of examples to enable people to learn how to apply Estate Planning to their own needs.
